

Terms and Conditions

It is important that you read and fully acknowledge the below Terms and Conditions before completing the MACCA booking form

- We reserve the right to exclude or refuse admission to children for disruptive, discriminatory offensive or violent behaviour or actions that may be considered to be a danger to themselves, coaching staff or other participants
- Please note that we operate a “three strikes and out” rule, whereby children will be warned three times (depending on the severity of the incident), and on the third warned the child’s parent/guardian will be contacted and the child will be sent home.
- All the activities are as described on the website (www.erewash.gov.uk/macca) and only for the age range and at the venue specified
- Please be aware that all activities are subject to change.
- Parents/Guardians have responsibility for notifying the centre if their child(ren) is/are unable to attend a session
- If parents/guardians are not collecting children directly from the leisure centre they must inform the centre in writing
- Children will be encouraged to participate in every session they are booked on, for the enjoyment of the group.
- Please note that no refunds will be given, unless for medical reasons supported by a doctor’s note.
- Erewash Borough Council operates a Child Protection Policy. If you have any concerns about any Council activity session, please contact the respective leisure centre’s manager.
- Every effort will be made to ensure that young people do not leave sessions early unless the proper authorisation has been granted by the parent/guardian. However, anyone who leaves against the express wishes of our staff or parents does so at their own risk. In such circumstances parents/guardians of the person leaving will be notified as soon as possible.
- We will ensure that no young person is left alone at the venue at the end of the session. Parents/guardians may give their permission for their child to register and release themselves from our sessions by signing the self-registration and release consent declaration on the booking form.
- Children should not arrive at the centre more than 15 minutes before the start of the first activity.
- Please inform us in writing if your child has any medical/special requirements
- Please be punctual when collecting children.
- We suggest that children do not bring valuable (e.g. mobile phones) to any MACCA session. Anything that is brought along, is done so at the owner’s risk.
