## Waste Management Legislation

### **The Duty of Care – Environmental Protection Act 1990, Section 34**

The Duty of Care is legislation that requires all reasonable steps to be taken to keep waste safe. Any person who passes waste to another must ensure that person is authorised to accept, transport, recycle or dispose of it safely. Failure to do so can result in an unlimited fine. The Duty of Care applies to anyone who produces or imports, keeps or stores, transports, treats, recycles or disposes of waste. It also applies to brokers arranging these activities.

**The Registration of Waste Carriers & Brokers – Control Of Pollution (Amendment) Act 1989 - The Controlled Waste (Registration of Carriers & Seizure of Vehicles) Regulations 1991**  
**Environmental Protection - Waste Management Licensing Regulations 1994 - Section 20 - Registration of Brokers**

If controlled waste (commercial, industrial and household waste) is transported within England and Wales as part of a business or in any other way for profit, then the carrier must register with the Environment Agency. Registration as a Waste Broker is also required for persons arranging for the collection, recovery or disposal of waste on behalf of another person. Registration is required regardless of how often controlled waste is transported and this applies to self-employed carriers as well as partnerships and companies. The Agency has stop and search powers and can demand to see proof of registration; failure to produce documentation can result in a fine of up to £5,000.

### **The Special Waste Regulations 1996 – Environmental Protection Act 1990, Section 62**

The Special Waste Regulations were introduced in September 1996 and revised the definition of special waste. Special wastes are wastes that have hazardous properties, and include acids, batteries, oils and solvents. Special waste producers must notify the Agency at least 72 hours before the waste is removed by filling in a five-part consignment note. Information sheets are available from the Agency on classification of special waste, use of the consignment note and obtaining and sending consignment notes.

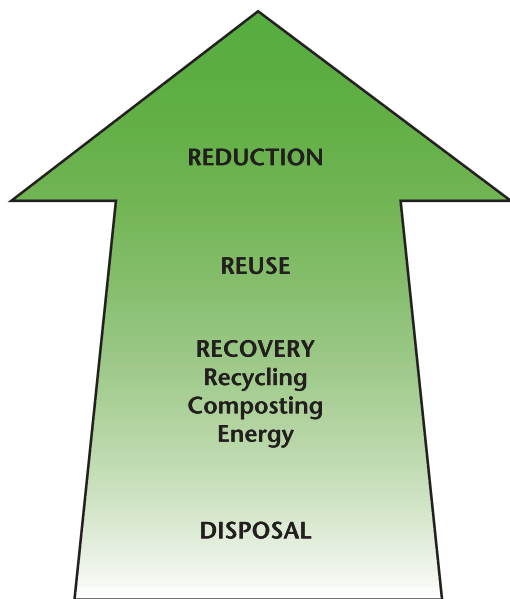
**The Producer Responsibility Obligations (Packaging Waste) Regulations 1997 – The Environment Act 1995, Sections 93-95**

Under the European Union Directive on Packaging and Packaging Waste (94/62 EC) at least 50% of the UK's packaging waste must be recovered or recycled by the year 2001. The aim of the UK Regulations is to ensure that the real environmental costs of producing, using and disposing of packaging fall directly on those who manufacture or use it. All businesses handling packaging have a share in the responsibility right along the chain – from production through to retail. If a business owns and handles over 50 tonnes of packaging materials or packaging each year and has an annual turnover of more than £2 million, then it is legally obliged to recover and recycle specific tonnages of packaging waste. Obligated companies may either register with the Agency or join a compliance scheme.

**Waste Minimisation and Recycling**

**The Waste Hierarchy**

The Government is committed to a move towards Sustainable Development. That is “development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs”. Applying this idea to the way that we manage waste provides a priority list of waste management options or Waste Hierarchy. The best solution is to avoid producing any waste in the first place – the zero waste option. The least favoured option is disposal, straight to a landfill.



Between these two lie the other preferred options, in order of preference. Re-use waste wherever possible, then recover its value by recycling into new products, compost to provide an agricultural benefit or use as fuel in energy generation. There is a well considered need to move waste management practices further up the

hierarchy. However, the waste hierarchy is just a guide and may not always indicate the best option for a particular waste stream. The final choice for a particular waste stream will be guided by a consideration of the ‘Best Practicable Environmental Option’ and include an assessment of economic costs and benefits.

**The National Waste Strategy**

The Government published Waste Strategy 2000 in May, setting out a vision of sustainable waste management in England and Wales for the next 20 years. The strategy is part of our continued commitment to Europe.

At the heart of the strategy lies the need to tackle the growth in waste and ‘the appropriate balance between different waste management options’ as defined by the Waste Hierarchy. The following benefits will be delivered by the strategy:

- Increasing diversion of waste from landfill
- Engaging the public in re-use and recycling schemes
- Curbing the rise in waste generation
- BPEO becomes the basis for waste management decisions
- Increasing awareness of end-of-life impacts of products
- Building markets for recycled products

Waste Strategy 2000 sets a range of challenging targets to help meet the aim of sustainable waste management.

**Waste Management**

**Waste Management**

Industry, commerce and households currently create 106 million tonnes of waste each year, most of which is sent to landfill. Municipal waste (waste collected by or on behalf of local authorities) accounts for some 27.8 million tonnes.

Figures from the Environment Agency's National Waste Production Survey (1998/99) indicated that the South West Region produced 5.2 million tonnes of industrial and commercial waste.

Table 1 below illustrates the amount and composition of industrial and commercial waste produced in the South West.

The main methods of waste management for this waste were disposal to land (46%) and recycling and re-use (32%).

In addition, some 2.5 million tonnes of municipal waste is produced in the Region annually, 85% is disposed to Landfill.

**Targets and Goals**

Waste Strategy 2000 sets a series of targets and goals to ensure the necessary step change in waste management delivers the Government’s vision and reduces the quantity of biodegradable municipal waste going to landfill.

Key targets and goals are:

- By 2005 to reduce the amount of industrial and commercial waste sent to landfill to 85% of that landfilled in 1998
- To recover 40% of municipal waste and recycle 25% of household waste by 2005
- To recover value from 45% of municipal waste by 2010, including recycling or composting 30% of household waste
- To recover 67% of municipal waste by 2015, 33% through recycling and composting
- To develop new and stronger markets for recycled materials

Through waste management licensing and enforcement activities, the Environment Agency ensures that waste management activities do not pollute the environment or damage human health.

The Agency also has advisory and information gathering roles, some of which have been highlighted in the waste strategy:

- Moving towards risk based assessment in the supervision of waste management facilities
- Developing Life Cycle Analysis (LCA) tools and techniques to help waste managers determine the BPEO for their wastes
- Disseminating results of waste surveys
- Assisting in the reduction of waste from industry and to ensure that waste is recovered where practicable



## Waste Minimisation

### What is the true cost of waste?

Research has shown the real cost of waste can be 5-20 times that of the disposal cost and can typically amount to 4% of turnover, although it can be as much as 10%. Waste is costly to produce in terms of time, effort, energy and materials, in addition to the effluent and disposal costs and potential harm to the environment.

Waste is not limited to solid controlled waste.

### What is waste minimisation?

Waste minimisation is the reduction of waste at source. It is better to prevent waste being produced in the first place than have to deal with it later – *prevention is usually cheaper than cure!* A waste minimisation programme considers how natural resources can be utilised more efficiently to reduce wastes.

### What are the benefits of minimising waste?

- **It saves money:** Waste minimisation results in increased operating efficiency, reduced production costs and reduced disposal costs.
- **Improves environmental performance and reduces risk:** Identification of environmental issues and improvement upon regulatory requirements means companies can reduce risks and liabilities and be more attractive to customers, investors and insurers.
- **Improves the environment:** Waste minimisation will benefit the environment through reduced raw material consumption and reducing other environmental impacts.

### How does waste minimisation work?

There are 3 key principles:

- Put IN only what is needed
- Get the most out of what's put IN
- Make the best of what comes OUT

*If you don't measure material and energy usage you can't manage them successfully.*

### Waste is a Resource

Waste is not simply material which is excess to requirement – it represents the loss of valuable company assets. A great deal of waste is avoidable through improved management of materials and energy. The true cost of waste includes the time, effort and materials to produce the waste and not simply the cost of disposal. Savings in these areas can contribute to increased profitability and competitiveness whilst benefiting the environment.

Using recycled materials in manufacturing instead of primary raw materials can save energy, conserve natural resources and reduce environmental and social damage. For example, composting removes organic waste from landfill and returns nutrients to the soil. The composting of commercial waste has risen from about 1,500 tonnes in 1993 to over 19,000 tonnes in 1997. There is untapped potential for substantial further increases.

### Good Environmental Management

There is no standard formula for reducing waste – each process/activity is different. A company may be able to improve its overall efficiency simply by avoiding leaks and spills, by better materials handling as well as by redesigning processes and products.

**Waste Minimisation continued**

It is vital to involve staff at all levels, informing everyone of the cost of waste and encouraging resource saving initiatives.

A key tool in the development of a waste minimisation strategy will be a systematic audit of waste generation and handling activities. It is now widely accepted that good housekeeping measures and modest investments based on thorough waste audits can yield substantial improvements in environmental performance. Payback times are typically found to be months rather than years. Detailed, step-by-step guidance is available for carrying out a waste/environmental audit as well as case histories which document successful projects. Contact the Environment Agency or Envirowise (see address details under Public Service Organisations).

Introducing a formal Environmental Management System (EMS) and involving employees and stakeholders can give rise to better environmental and economic performance. There exist a number of schemes, structured to enable an organisation to identify, monitor and control its environmental aspects. These aspects can include energy management, waste minimisation, raw material management, environmental emissions, noise control and accident procedures eg ISO 14001, EMAS.

The EMS approach is based on the principle of continual improvement. The performance of an organisation is monitored and measured against objectives and targets, which it has set itself in its environmental policy. These may be reviewed and the policy updated to achieve higher standards.

**...further help from the Environment Agency...**

The Agency has produced a number of leaflets to encourage business to utilise good environmental management, for example:-

- The Agency has produced a good practice guide which offers step-by-step assistance to reduce production costs by developing a practical plan to minimise waste generation and to improve the handling and disposal of waste.
- In conjunction with Groundwork and WWF-UK, the Agency has produced 'Eliminate' a waste awareness training game, a unique approach to waste awareness in industry.
- The Agency has also produced a guide to help organisations get staff involved in waste minimisation. It provides information on how to develop an Action Plan for a staff awareness campaign and contains posters, example newsletters and environmental facts and figures to help promote staff awareness within an organisation.

In the interests of space the directory listing has been divided in to two sections. The first, from page 11, is an alphabetical list of commonly recycled commercial wastes. Below each waste is some material specific information followed by an alphabetical list of companies who offer a recycling service for that specific waste. The second section, from page 40, is a complete listing of all the above named companies with complete address and contact details. Simply look for the waste you wish to recycle in the first

section, note the companies involved and then refer to the company index for their contact details.

Later sections of the directory provide contact details for many other local, regional and nationally important contacts within the broader context of sound environmental management from local authority recycling officers, regional environmental management forums to national trade associations and government initiatives.

You are reminded of your constant obligations under Section 34 Environmental Protection Act 1990 with respect to the management of your commercial/industrial wastes, namely:

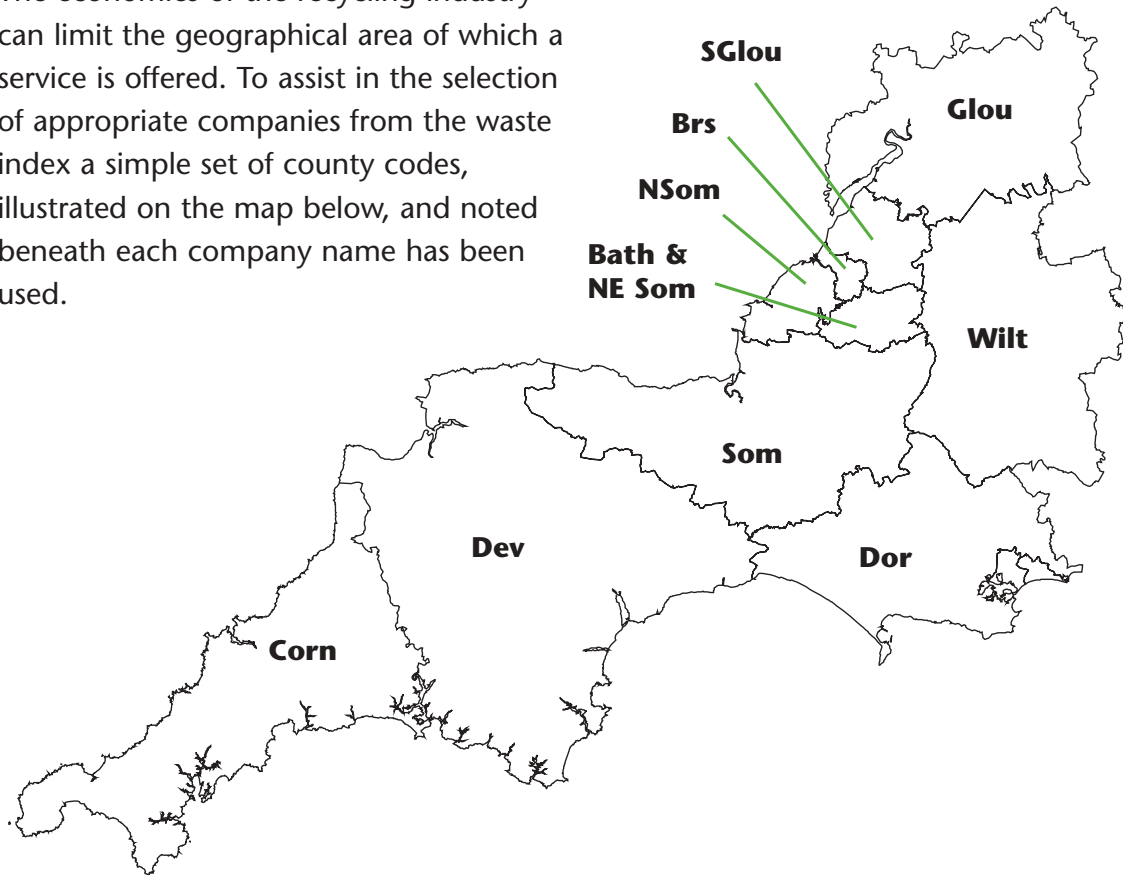
That the holder of the waste must keep it under control, store it safely and securely, and prevent it causing pollution or harming anyone. Actions to achieve this include:

- Ensuring the waste is secured and kept in a suitable container;
- Ensuring when the waste is given to someone else that they have the authority to take it. The law states that the person to whom the waste is given must be authorised to take it; and
- Ensuring a waste transfer note, which includes a description of the waste, is completed and signed.

Waste transfer notes must be kept by each holder for a minimum of two years.

**The area**

The economies of the recycling industry can limit the geographical area of which a service is offered. To assist in the selection of appropriate companies from the waste index a simple set of county codes, illustrated on the map below, and noted beneath each company name has been used.

**Batteries**

Batteries contain a variety of chemicals and heavy metals such as mercury, lead and cadmium which can cause pollution and harm to health. Metals recovered from battery recycling operations can be fed into the traditional metal markets. Recycling of lead/acid batteries and silver/oxide batteries are currently economically viable.

Consumption of lead/acid batteries for use in vehicles is about ten million per year. Although this represents less than 2% of the total number of batteries sold, lead/acid batteries account for over 80% of waste batteries in terms of weight. Approximately 90% are currently recycled and they can be collected at larger 'scrap yards'. The UK has no facilities for recycling the general purpose zinc/carbon and alkaline/manganese batteries. These represent about 80% of all batteries sold and are the only batteries that do not contain any toxic heavy metals. Nickel cadmium rechargeable batteries are highly toxic and should be recycled. Collected NiCd batteries are sent to France for recycling. Anybody in the UK wanting to dispose of their NiCd batteries responsibly should in the first instance seek guidance from either the distributor where they purchased the battery, the battery manufacturer or the appliance manufacturer.

Mercury oxide button batteries used in watches, cameras and hearing aids should be recycled where possible for their mercury content via some jewellers, photographic shops or NHS hospitals. Mobile phone batteries should be returned to your mobile phone retailer.

**Chemicals**

Chemical wastes are often likely to be considered Special Wastes and require highly specialised recovery, recycling and disposal. Due to the hazardous nature of these wastes there is a strict system of consignment, transfer and treatment under the Special Waste Regulations- Contact your local Environment Agency office if in any doubt about the status and procedures for transfer/disposal of chemical wastes.

Chemical wastes, as a term, can cover a wide range of substances. Specialist recovery services exist for the printing industry and solvents in general. See also company listings under Oils.

Call the Environmental Helpline 0800 585794 for a range of best practice case studies on solvent use. In-house recycling is also possible because dirty solvents can still be cleaned when they contain up to 15% solids, particularly if they are filtered effectively. The final option should be recruiting an external contractor to reprocess solvents back into new products.

**Construction and Demolition**

Quarrying and extraction of raw materials for use in construction can be unsightly and environmentally damaging in terms of air and visual pollution and increased transport. Each year in the UK an estimated 72 million tonnes of waste arises from construction and demolition. Of this, 35% is recycled and 13% is used as low grade filler or landfill cover and 24% is landfilled as waste (Information taken from the National Survey carried out by the Environment Agency and DEFRA and reported in the Strategic Waste Management Assessment). Much more could be put to better use if separated at source. Waste materials that have been recovered from construction sites include masonry and mortar (which can be re-used as hardcore), slate cladding, roofing timbers etc.

**Drums and Containers - Contaminated Metal**

Bulk purchasing in refillable containers is recommended wherever possible in order to reduce the number of disposed drums and containers. Metal drums containing potentially hazardous or toxic residues have little scrap value and demand care in their disposal. Where possible reuse will divert containers from the waste stream, but where this is not appropriate, contractors will take drums for material recycling.

Drums and containers for chemicals, particularly hazardous substances, may need to be consigned, transferred and recycled as special waste due to residue left behind after use. Please see details under the legislation section or contact your local Environment Agency office if unsure.

**Electronics and Electrical Equipment**

Approximately six million obsolete pieces of electronic equipment are discarded in the UK annually. Networks are developing in order to recycle the high value contained in this waste stream. Items such as computers, photocopiers and fax machines contain printed circuit boards that have valuable metals such as copper, gold and platinum in their components. Electronic equipment is also collected so that components such as disc drives in computers can be reused. Plastic casings can also be recycled: however, with older machines the identification of plastic can be difficult. The Industry Council is promoting design for disassembly to enable further recycling and the proposed European Directive on Waste from Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) is setting targets for further reuse and recycling. Facilities to process white goods to recover metal are well established, and it has been estimated that over 75% of UK arisings of white goods are recycled.

**Fluorescent Tubes**

Of the 80 million fluorescent tubes sold in the UK each year only a tiny fraction are recycled. Tubes are suitable for recycling because they consist principally of glass, metal and approximately 15 mg of mercury. The aluminium end caps are separated and recycled, mercury is washed out and collected for reuse in tube manufacture and the contaminated glass powder is used as a bulking product in mineral extraction. Several waste management companies are now offering a collection service to take tubes for recycling.

Many waste foods can be reused as animal feed or recycled. In particular there has been an increase in the network of waste cooking oil and solidified fat processors. Vegetable oil has a similar polluting effect as mineral oil and solidified fat will block drains very effectively. Recovered and filtered, these wastes have substantial economic value for processing and reuse. Other options for organic wastes (also see green waste) include anaerobic digestion, fermentation or vermiculture (worm composting), all of which yield a quality soil treatment product.

**Gas Cylinders**

Liquid petroleum gas cylinders are legally the property of the gas company branded on the cylinder. They must not be disposed of or sold as scrap metal. Defacing or resale may result in legal proceedings by the gas company. The Cylinder Retrieval Scheme has been set up by the Liquid Petroleum Gas Association (LPGA) to ensure safe storage and return of LP gas cylinders discarded at scrap merchants, civic amenity sites and landfill. When a total of 20 LP gas cylinders are held on site, the designated gas supply company should be contacted to arrange collection. Calor and BOC LP cylinders are excluded from this service and they should be contacted directly when a minimum of 3 LP cylinders are held. Individual arrangements should be made for collection of LP cylinders which are owned by non-participating companies of either scheme.

Manufacture of new containers from crushed glass, known as cullet, requires it to be strictly colour separated. Most of the glass which is collected is container glass. The other source is waste flat glass which is recovered primarily from off-cuts of the glazing trade, although some is from building demolition, car dismantlers and garages, and is collected and processed by specialist companies.

Waste glass arisings in the UK are estimated to be around 2.5 million tonnes per annum. This is higher than the UK production of container glass of about 2.0 million tonnes per annum, partly because the UK imports a considerable amount of products, particularly wine, in green glass containers. The amount of glass recycled in the UK in 1997 was 511,000 tonnes, with an overall glass recycling rate of 26%. Some EC countries such as Austria, Denmark, Germany, Belgium and the Netherlands achieve recycling rates of better than 60%.

**Oil**

Most of the waste oil is collected from commercial or industrial premises. It is estimated that about 420,000 tonnes of waste lubricating oil was collected in 1997, which represents between 85% and 90% of estimated arisings. The percentage of lubricating oil being collected almost doubled between 1985 and 1997.

There are three treatment options;

- re-refining to produce a new recycled oil, water and a residue;
- laundering used to process oil of known composition, such as hydraulic oils and cutting oils; after treatment the oil is returned to the company that supplied it for reuse; and
- fuel production, which is the most common option and a much simpler process than either re-refining or laundering; it involves removing water and the solid contaminants collected during use.

Used oil filters can be crushed and recycled for their oil and metal components.

The sales of lubricating oil in the UK in 1997 amounted to 872,500 tonnes. This figure includes not only engine oil and gear and transmission oils, but also greases, metalworking oils, and other oils. However, factors such as leakages and the combustion of oil in engines means that the actual arisings of waste oil are lower than the amount consumed. Currently it is estimated that waste oil arisings represent 55% of consumption, which means waste oil arisings in 1997 were about 480,000 tonnes.

**Plastics**

Plastics waste arisings are estimated to be about 3.8 million tonnes per annum. As a proportion of plastics consumption, the post-use recycling rate is about 5% of estimated plastic waste arisings.

For most recycling companies, post use material must be segregated and bailed into significant quantities of essentially clean, single product material. Many recycling companies at present handle plastic only as a single polymer type, which they convert into granulate or a recompounded pellet. The recycling results in a single polymer material which can be used with virgin material in a range of non-food contact applications.

**Plastics - EPS (Expanded Polystyrene) 7**

Mechanically recycled EPS can go back into new EPS foam, widely used by the construction industry. It can also be reused as 'loosefill' packaging by the packaging industry. One of the most novel uses of recycled EPS is a hardwood substitute which can be sawn, nailed or screwed just like wood.

**Plastics - LDPE (Low Density Polyethylene) 4**

Polyethylene film is used as shrink wrap and agricultural silage wrap. It is estimated that around 50,000 tonnes of polyethylene film, about 10% of total UK production, is recovered every year to provide useful and serviceable goods such as certain types of builders sheeting and black refuse bags, the majority of which are made from recycled material.

**Plastics - PETE (Polyethylene Terephthalate)**

Plastics waste arisings are estimated to be about 3.8 million tonnes per annum. The post-use recycling rate is about 5% of estimated plastic waste arisings. By far the largest proportion of plastics recycled is polyethylene film (about 50%).

Recycled Polyethylene Terephthalate (PET) bottles can end up as a fibre in filling for anoraks and sleeping bags. New technology is enabling high quality fleece clothing to be manufactured from used PET bottles.

**Plastics - PP (Polypropylene)**

At least 25,000 tonnes of polypropylene are recycled annually, equivalent to about 7% of total UK production. More than 70% of this material has had a full service life with major sources being bottle crates and car battery boxes. The recycled material is used in high quality applications such as injection mouldings and extruded drainage pipes.

In the UK every year over six million toner cartridges are used. It is estimated that about 50% of these end up in landfill sites. Cartridge consumption is currently rising in the UK by 15% per year. A toner cartridge is a non-biodegradable product made from durable plastic housing a metal corona wire, selenium OPC drum and residual toner. Toner cartridges from printers, copiers and fax machines are a valuable waste product that are often bought, collected as part of a reduced rate refill and return scheme or collected free of charge by certain charities.

**Textiles and Clothing**

The total arisings of textile waste are estimated to be about 650,000 tonnes per year, most of which comes from household sources. Approximately 25% of textile waste arisings are reused as cleaning and wiping cloths, flocked filling material for upholstery or sound proofing, yarn from recycled fibres and re-wearable clothing. Second-hand garments sold for further use generate the best income because processing is minimal, costs are low and there is a large, growing market. Most UK exports of recycled clothing (over 60%) go to Africa.

The value of recycled textiles depends upon the quality of the feedstock, in terms of colour, fibre type and fabric purity. Broadly speaking, the preference is for white, natural unmixed fibres as opposed to coloured, synthetic or mixed fibres which are more difficult and thus costly to process.

**Tyres**

In the UK we travel some 650 billion passenger kilometres by road every year, and about 65% of goods are moved by road. Tyres are used in agricultural and industrial machinery, and for transport ranging from aeroplanes to bicycles. More and more tyres are being used and further increases are expected over the next 25 years. This consumption uses non renewable resources in tyre production, causes emissions to air, land and water during their use, and requires management at the end of use.

The best options for used tyres is retreading, a long established practice for road haulage and aircraft undercarriage tyres. Retreads are currently being promoted in car use.

A large number of tyres are landfilled each year which is not a sustainable disposal option. This practice is about to cease as the EU Directive on Landfill will ban the disposal of whole tyres to landfill by about 2003, and shredded tyres by 2006. More reuse, material recycling and energy recovery options are needed.

**Wood**

The total amount of wood waste arising in the UK are about 750,000 tonnes per annum, of which about 300,000 tonnes is packaging. Approximately 300,000 tonnes per year of waste wood is currently being recycled, and this is expected to increase to about 500,000 tonnes over the next few years.

The main secondary market is chipboard production. Other markets, such as mulch, animal bedding, and the all weather exercise rings for horses, are quite small by comparison. Sawdust obtained from shredding wood packaging can be used as an absorbent material for cleaning up liquid spills. Roofing timbers can be used in the furniture industry.

Wood wastes are utilised as a fuel throughout the UK wood processing industry. This is because of the limited opportunities to market waste wood as commercial fuel, due to the high transport costs, and because of the growing use of waste wood in chipboard production.

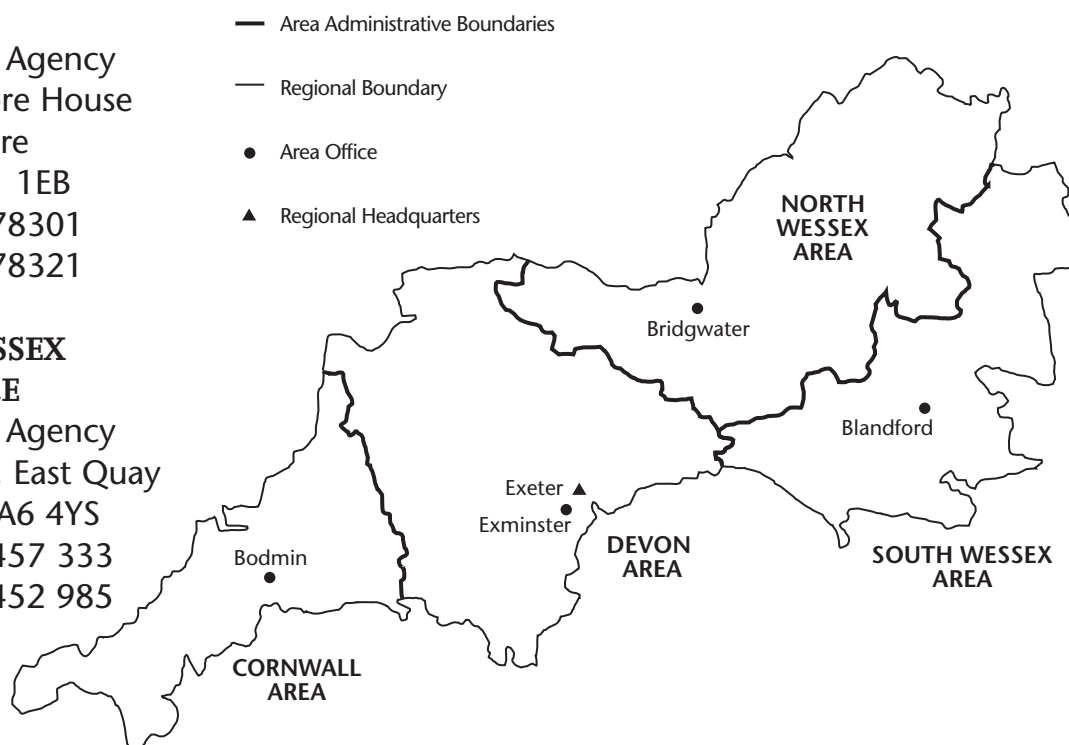
