- I am concerned about biodiversity. This incorporates wildlife, ecology, nature conservation, habitats and species so not just wildlife. This will impact endangered species e.g. Bats currently protected under EU Law as this law still stands and dormouse etc. There have been buzzards living in the wood since I moved there aged 8. There are birds that live there listed in schedule 1 of the Wildlife and Country Act. I am aware of Ciri bunting, Harriers, Heron, Kingfisher, Barn Owl, Peregrine, Darford Warbler and Woodlark. I am concerned about the hedgerows around the site, the trees in the woods etc.
Shame on you if you progress with these plans and I hope the Spondon Councillors and Planning team fight this all the way.
