- 1. More families but no school places. West Park secondary school the nearest secondary to this development is already oversubscribed
- 2. Many more cars will be inevitable and the traffic getting out of Spondon to Derby is already very difficult and at peak times Willowcroft Road is at a standstill. The environment impact of this is concerning and should also be tested and shared.
- 3. The 2 Doctors surgeries in Spondon Village are at capacity and it is really difficult to get a same day appointment, this will become much **much** worse with additional housing.
- 4. It is Greenbelt land! The Deer and wildlife are amazing around this land and they will lose their home and I fear cause car accidents on the roads surrounding where the development is proposed as they look for new land. Protected land should be protected!

- 5. Erewash council have deliberately chosen land on the border that will not use resources from Erewash but in fact Derby City Council, this is plain to see and underhand. There are no proposals to invest in the infrastructure and resources that would be needed in Spondon to accommodate these houses from the council.
- 6. The average reading age in the UK is age 9. The way in which Erewash Council has proceeded with this is unclear, even to the point of this form!! How is an average person supposed to object clearly with all of these hoops. I suspect a large proportion of original objectors will not resubmit due to the unclear process and communication which seems illegal, at best unethical.
