Description
<p>A school, built in 1921. Designed by George Widdows. It is built of brown brick beneath a hipped plain tile roof. The plan form was originally "T" shaped, with a linear range to the front and a hall to the rear. The front elevation is single storey, with a two storey central bay. To either side, there is a pair of tall window openings that break the eaves, beneath hipped dormers.</p> <p>An account of the architect's life can be found in the Oxford Dictionary of National Biography.</p> <p>George Widdows is considered to be a nationally important architect. His works are generally considered to have special architectural interest.</p>

There are contemporary farm buildings to the rear.</p> <p>Buildings that predate the reign of Queen Victoria are considered to have qualities of age that justify their inclusion on the Local List.</p>

There are contemporary farm buildings to the west, in residential use.</p> <p>Buildings that predate the reign of Queen Victoria are considered to have qualities of age that justify their inclusion on the Local List.</p>

The front elevation features a narrow stair window flanked by square window openings that are open to the eaves.</p> <p>Buildings that predate the reign of Queen Victoria are considered to have qualities of age that justify their inclusion on the Local List. The farmstead is unlikely to date to before c.1700 (the "brick threshold").</p>

<p>A house, built before (or shortly after) the accession of Queen Victoria. The house is faced in smooth render beneath a gabled concrete tile roof with oversailing eaves. It is two storeys tall. There is an off-centre projecting porch flanked by square window openings.</p> <p>The property was extended to the left in 1998.</p> <p>The appearance of this building on an early Victorian parish map indicates that it may have qualities of age that would justify its inclusion on the Local List. The building is unlikely to date to before c.1700 (the "brick threshold").</p>

There is a central entrance door flanked by elongated window openings with segmental heads.</p> <p>The property was divided into two dwellings in 2008.</p> <p>Buildings that predate the reign of Queen Victoria are considered to have qualities of age that justify their inclusion on the Local List.</p>
